

## Municipal general election on November 2, 2025

### IS YOUR DOMICILE LOCATED OUTSIDE THE MUNICIPALITY OR RCM?

You may have the right to vote if you are the **owner of an immovable** or if you have been the **occupant of a business establishment** in the municipality or in the RCM since September 18, 2025, or before.

You may be entitled to this right if, for instance, you are:

- The owner of an apartment building;
- The co-owner of a cottage or second home;
- The tenant of a commercial space.

To have the right to vote, you must be 18 years of age or older on election day and be a Canadian citizen on November 2, 2025. You must not have lost the right to vote due to a tutorship or be deprived of your electoral rights on that date.

To exercise your voting right, you must submit an application for registration on the municipal list of electors, the RCM list of electors or the referendum list.

#### HOW TO APPLY\*

- If you are the sole owner of an immovable or the **sole occupant** of a business establishment, fill the attached SMR-9.2 form;
- If you are the **co-owner** of an immovable or the **co-occupant** of a business establishment, designate one person among the group to be registered on the list and fill the attached SMR-9.1 form.

You must send the completed form to the address indicated below.

The application for registration on the list of electors or power of attorney remains valid until it is replaced or withdrawn. If you want to replace or withdraw an existing application or power of attorney, please contact the returning officer.

\*For the application to be valid for the 2025 election, the municipality must receive it **by the set deadline for making an application to amend with the board of revisors**. The returning officer will specify the date in the coming months.
